Classroom Procedures and Expectations

This year, FAO has adopted the "Clip Chart" for positive behavior management. It is a great way to provide feedback to the students and to reinforce positive behaviors

There are 7 steps to the clip chart.

- If students clip up to a level 5, 6, or 7 they receive a PACK ticket which makes them eligible to win a drawing and receive a prize from Mrs. Ruiz's prize box. The student has not only met expectations consistently, but they have demonstrated exemplary behavior including, but not limited to: helping others, volunteering, and independently leading others in positive choices.
 - The students begin on a level 4 and are expected to remain on a level 4 throughout the day.

 This means they have stayed on task, followed instructions, and demonstrated great PACK behavior.
 - Students has received a warning and given an opportunity to reflect on their behavior in order to regain focus, and continue with a positive attitude.
 - 2 Student has had time to reflect and continue to demonstrate non-cooperative behaviors and reflect outside of the classroom.
 - Parents are contacted and student makes an office visit
